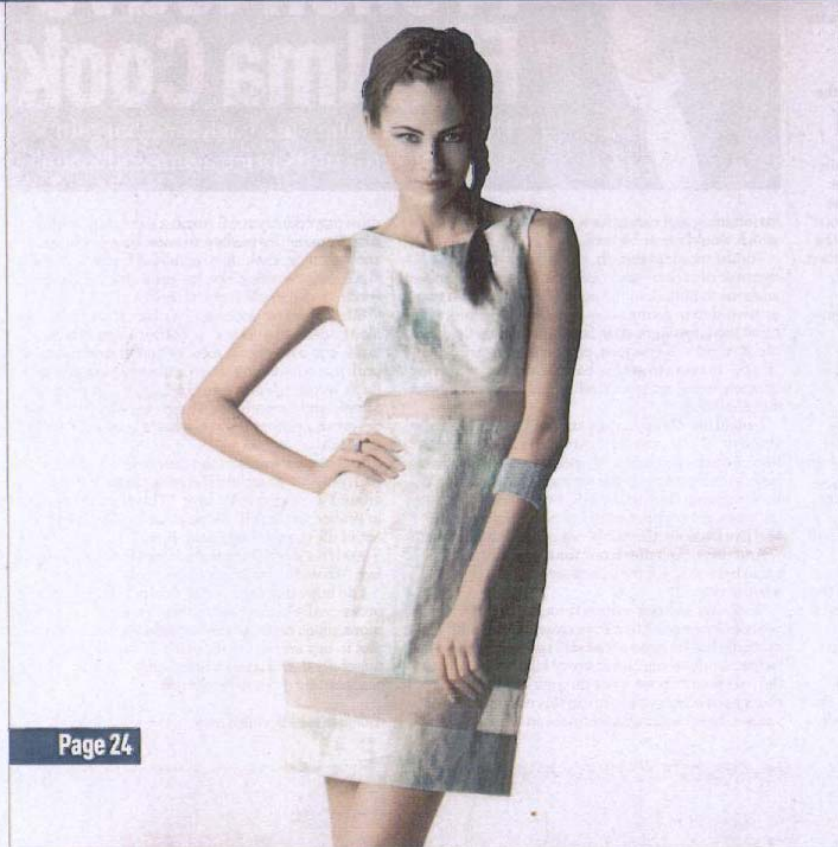

## SCOTTISH FASHION AWARDS 2010

**F**rom luxurious silks to baby-soft cashmere, the nominees for the Scottish Fashion Awards 2010 are as varied as the materials they bring alive. With globally respected designers such as Christopher Kane and Jonathan Saunders heading up the Designer Of The Year category, to up-and-coming talents like Holly Fulton and Louise Gray vying for the title of Young Designer Of The Year, this year's event promises to be one of the strongest yet.

"The mix in the Designer Of The Year category is very good," says Dolly Jones, editor of Vogue.com, who is on the judging panel for this year's awards. "With names like Christopher Kane in there, who is an undeniable talent, and Pam Hogg, who has such a different story to tell with her fashion label coming back again in the last few years, it's looking like a really strong category."

Although Jones has yet to make her final choices, she admits judging will be difficult. "Each of the nominees for the Designer Of The Year category has their own story," she says. "Kane has won the award in the past, but he's such a strong talent you would expect him to. Then there's Saunders, who has recently come back to London and taken his label to a new level in business terms. Pam Hogg's clothing inspires such fun. Clare Waight Keller and Graeme Black have their own stories too and each is respected in the fashion community. It will be down to which story each judge wants to highlight."

On June 20 the awards ceremony will take place in Glasgow Science Centre – the first time the event has been held in the city. The Herald and Sunday Herald are media partners for the event.

"The Scottish Fashion Awards are in their fifth year and the event is seen as a stamp of approval for Scottish design talent," adds Tessa Hartmann, the event's founder. "Not only does it serve to highlight people and make them household names, it rewards those who already are." ■
